## **CPCA Minutes**

## April 17, 2018

All board members in attendance except for Maurice Welsh.

The meeting was called to order by Dominick Gendusa at 6:07pm.

- Jason Hawks made a motion to approve March meeting minutes, seconded by Kevin Grace, all in favor
- Kevin Grace gave financial report:
  - Deposits in March: \$17,850
  - Checks Written in March: \$8,879.28
  - Current Checking Account balance: \$138,231.91
  - Current Savings Account balance: \$92,029.20
  - 20 Lots have not paid their 2018 CPCA dues
  - o 11 Non-PC&R Lots have not paid their 2018 CPCA dues
- Dominick Gendusa gave report on community pool.
- Dominick Gendusa gave report on the status of the pond fountain pump.
- Kevin Grace gave report of 2018 Golf Tournament.
- Kevin Grace made a motion to hold a raffle with the payment of one lot's 2019 CPCA dues as the prize with the proceeds going to the social committee. Seconded by Jason Hawks, all in favor.
- Dominick Gendusa gave an update regarding community security:
  - Guards will be from Innerparish Security
  - Car Decals have been received, distribution procedure is being determined
  - The board is accepting and evaluating bids for a new security camera system.
  - Feasibility to install a phone and internet service at guard house is being determined, contributed by Andy Turcotte.
  - Implications regarding access to the Carter Cemetery area.
  - Livingston Parish Sherriff's office to provide direction on proper security functions and powers the CPCA can employ.
- Dominick Gendusa led a discussion on consolidating CPCA physical and digital records.
- Dominick Gendusa presented the strategy and procedure for bringing the Tall Timbers neighborhood into the PC&R
